# What is an authenticator app?

An authenticator app is a security tool that generates time-sensitive codes on your mobile device. This provides an extra layer of protection beyond passwords for online accounts.

# If you answer the questions incorrectly, your account will be created but you will not be able to complete a FAFSA!

- An email will also be sent to you with the same instructions.
- Contact the Federal Student Aid Information Center (FSAIC) at 1-800-433-3243.
- A customer service representative will review your account and initiate the identity verification process.
- You will receive an email with a case number and instructions for providing the required documentation to verify your identity.
- Submit the required documentation.
- Within 1-3 days, you will receive an email from FSA confirming that your identity has been verified.
