

Earlham College Retention & Graduation Rates

Last updated October 19th, 2023

The tables and graphics below contain the Fall to Fall retention rates of cohorts 2014-2022, and the 6-year graduation rates of cohorts 2014-2017 for first-time, degree seeking students who attended Earlham College full-time in the Fall Semester of the cohort years specified. The rates are disaggregated by Gender (Binary), Pell Status and Race/Ethnicity/Citizenship. Please note that groups with fewer than 5 students were suppressed to protect students' identities.

Notes

- First-Time, Full-Time Students are those students who enter Earlham in the Fall semester as full-time students who have not previously been enrolled as full-time students at a different institution.
- Fall to Fall retention refers to the percentage of first-time, full-time students who enrolled in the Fall and returned for the subsequent Fall semester (i.e., the Fall semester of their 2nd year)
- Graduation Rate refers to the percentage of first-time, full-time students who earned their Earlham degree within the specified time range.
- International status, ethnicity and race are reported following IPEDS Standards in a single variable. Students who are not U.S Citizens or permanent residents are reported as "International". Domestic Hispanic students are reported by ethnicity (Hispanic) and not by race. The remaining categories are for non-Hispanic domestic students, based on race. All students in the "unknown" category are domestic students. Due to a change in data collection, there are many more students in the "unknown" category in the 2016 cohort and earlier. Student privacy is protected by suppressing retention and graduation rates for groups smaller than 5, which includes Native American Students (in no year were there more than 5 Native American students) and Asian multiracial students in some years, as well as students- with unknown race/ethnicity in some years.
- **Gender (Binary)** was used instead of the Gender Inclusive disaggregation to protect students' identities, as some groups in the Gender-non-conforming category were smaller than 5. In this type of reporting, Cisgender & Transgender women are coded as Women, and Cisgender & Transgender Men are coded as men. When self-identified gender is not disclosed, legal sex is used.
